- 7. Key Communicator update (Tanis James):
 - Attended COSC meeting a couple of weeks ago. Meeting on April 23 (2 weeks ago). Update from school trustees. The presentation is available online on CBE website. About 86 people present. Covered the budget update, capital planning update, and breakout rooms to meet local trustees. Met Patricia Volger (sp) in the breakout room. CBE having problems with the new budget. Received a \$55M increase in budget from the CBE, but there has been a per-child increase in real costs. CBE was hoping for \$238M. Increased special needs, school utilities. Per student funding lower in Alberta than other provinces. Implored everyone present to advocate to the province. Have seen 20,000 student increase. Project

- 160,000 kids by 2029. Talked about overcrowding, 33 schools overflowing to other schools. Some conversation about how they do the capital planning.
- o Trustees are happy to attend school council meetings, they just have to ask.
- Shelley says that the Alberta School Council Association has had its funding cut too (\$600,000 to \$15,000) ASCA will be forming a Facebook group for school councils
- Suggested inviting our school trustee to the second parent council meeting (the one after the AGM).
- Farouk will take the initiative to invite our school trustee to the next meeting
